

# Other Items

**Food:** All interns will be given a food allowance for weekly shopping, each person will be responsible for making their own food and keeping their apartments and dishes clean. Laundry service will be provided weekly as part of the package.

**Transportation:** No intern will drive a personal vehicle in Honduras; all transportation will be provided with a driver to go to work sites, projects and shopping etc. A Transportation schedule will be provided at orientation along with all information on budgets.

**Finances:** Everything that is required for your stay with us is provided for you, housing, transportation, shopping (groceries). We do not provide computers but we do provide internet access that is part of your package. The funds you are given each week are to be used for the purchase of food and personal supplies as needed. An ample budget is given for you to accomplish this but it does not include eating out or buying non essential items. If you choose to bring cash then you are responsible for those funds.

**Medical:** We do not provide any medical coverage while you are here, we do of course have facilities to use but the cost of any health care would be the responsibility of the intern or sponsor.

**Air Travel:** Any travel outside the work place including travel to arrive in Honduras is the responsibility of the Intern or sponsor. While you are here we do have ways to receive money from your sponsor if you need that service. Information on that would be provided during the acceptance of application for Admission into the program.

**Approval:** In order to be accepted into the program all forms on the application must be filled out and returned to us for evaluation. You would receive a letter from us upon approval if your application is denied you will receive a full explanation to the reason.
