From that humble beginning once again of the "Street Kids Project" comes a cry from those being both physically and emotionally defeated when trying to stand up and lead. Invicto translates to Undefeated, and is our newest of ministries to assist the young men and woman 15 - 20 years of age to be leaders. This program has yet to be funded through donations and is in the stages of program development. It is our prayer that we will see funding to produce this program enabling us to offer these special young people a chance to learn, receive support and mentoring and be taught, challenged and inspired to become leaders in church and community. We are blessed to have as one of our new ministries "Mis Corderos". We have been able to begin a child feeding program for kids under 10 years old that do not experience meals on a daily basis. We provide one meal a day of local style food that is balanced and healthy and provides the child also with fruit and fresh water. We are able to provide that meal for 30 Lempira or \$1.58. As donations for the program are received we will provide more meals. Currently we have long lists of children from the communities that far exceed what we are financially able to do. It is truly a blessing to see a few of these kids sit down to a simple meal and enjoy the feeling of love. It is also heartbreaking to have to watch and say no to others as there is never enough for everyone. We pray this ministry grows in financial support as we provide nourishment for both the stomach and the spirit. The children also learn to say Grace at this meal giving thanks to God.



Four years ago we began the "Street Kids Project" and it was not only a success but became larger than we could have ever imagined. Through that project ministries have been birthed and inspired from the Holy Spirit. ALBANZA is our outreach Youth Choir that began 1 1/2 years ago. This program has a volunteer Ms Deborah Prieskop who has 35 years experience as a music teacher. Ms Deborah not only teaches our kids songs but how to correctly sing them. We teach and administer to the kids and provide for them performances in Church, community and holiday activities throughout the Island of Roatan. We provide transportation for kids from other

communities to join with us once a week to practice. Once again funding is needed to pay expenses and provide the kids with transportation, shirts, printing and supplies and hopefully visits to places like the United States.
